What is Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)?

The law governing „Environmental Impact Assessment“ (EIA Act) imposes this type of assessment as mandatory in the construction of certain plants. Environmental impact assessment must be carried out to exclude harmful factors. Impacts on people, fauna, flora, soil, water, air, climate, landscape, cultural and physical assets, including the relevant interactions must be evaluated.

Reasons in favor of EIA

An EIA comprehensively investigates the relevant environmental impacts of a project and is aimed at minimizing unexpected and adverse effects in line with the principle of prevention. Assessment is systematic, cross-media, integrated and plausible.

EIA laws have been passed in all EU Member States, but also in numerous other countries inside and outside Europe.
